- o Position holders and voters must be direct descendants of the Pitcairn Settlers who arrived on Norf'k Ailen on 8th June 1856.
- o You must have been a full time Resident on Norf'k Ailen for the past 5 years and currently resides full time on Norf'k Ailen.
- o Attained the age of 25 years.
- o Voters must attend in person on the day of election.

Any person interested in a position, or wish to register to vote, please provide your name and proof of ancestry relationship (eg. great grandmother parents name) to the Pitcairn Settlers who arrived on Norf'k Ailen 8th June 1856 and email to: office-people@government.nf before 5pm Friday 29th December 2023.

How to vote for the nominated candidates will be provided on the day at the booth, held in the Old Military Barracks, Kingston, Norf'k Ailen.
